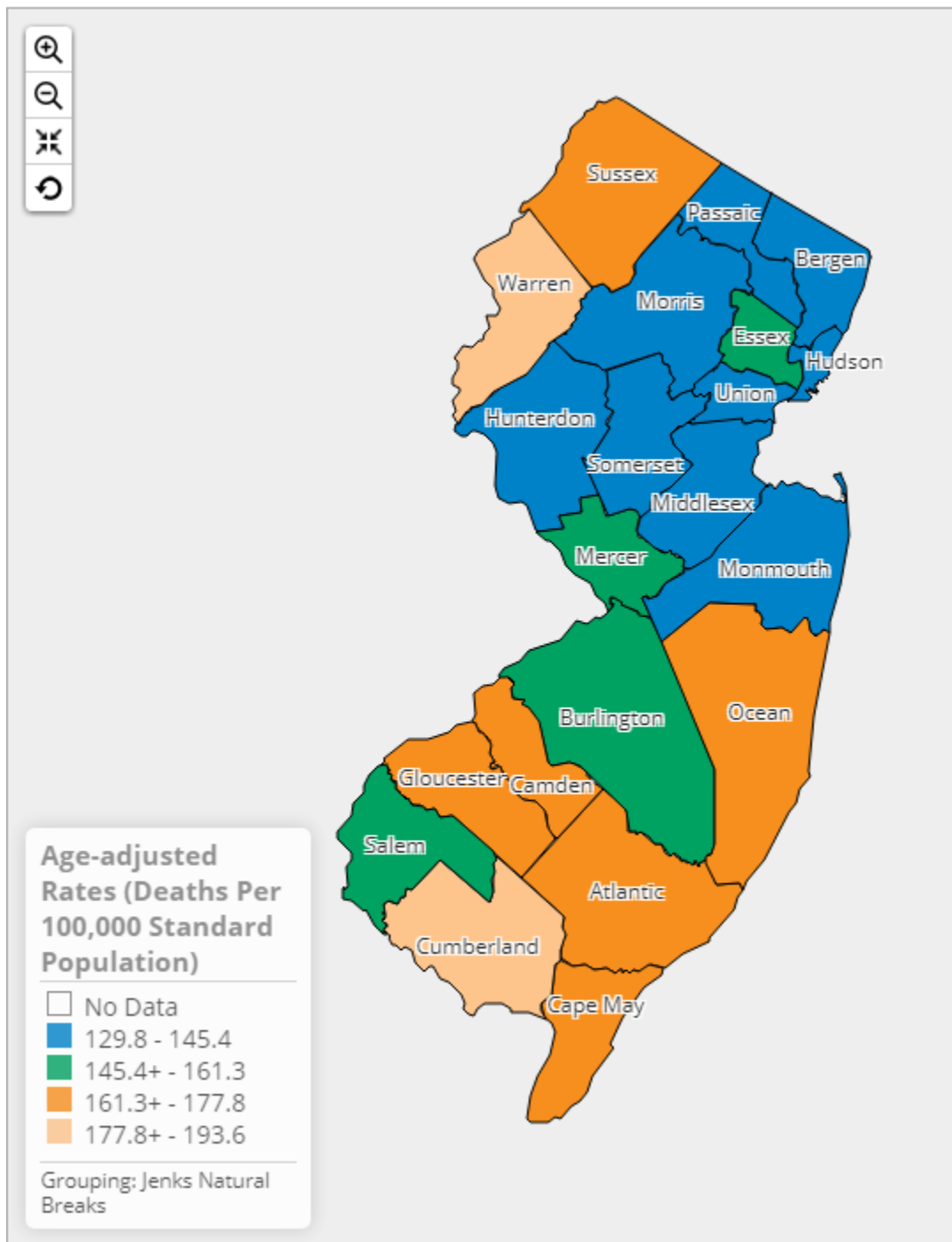


## Age-adjusted Death Rate due to Cancer, New Jersey Residents, 2015



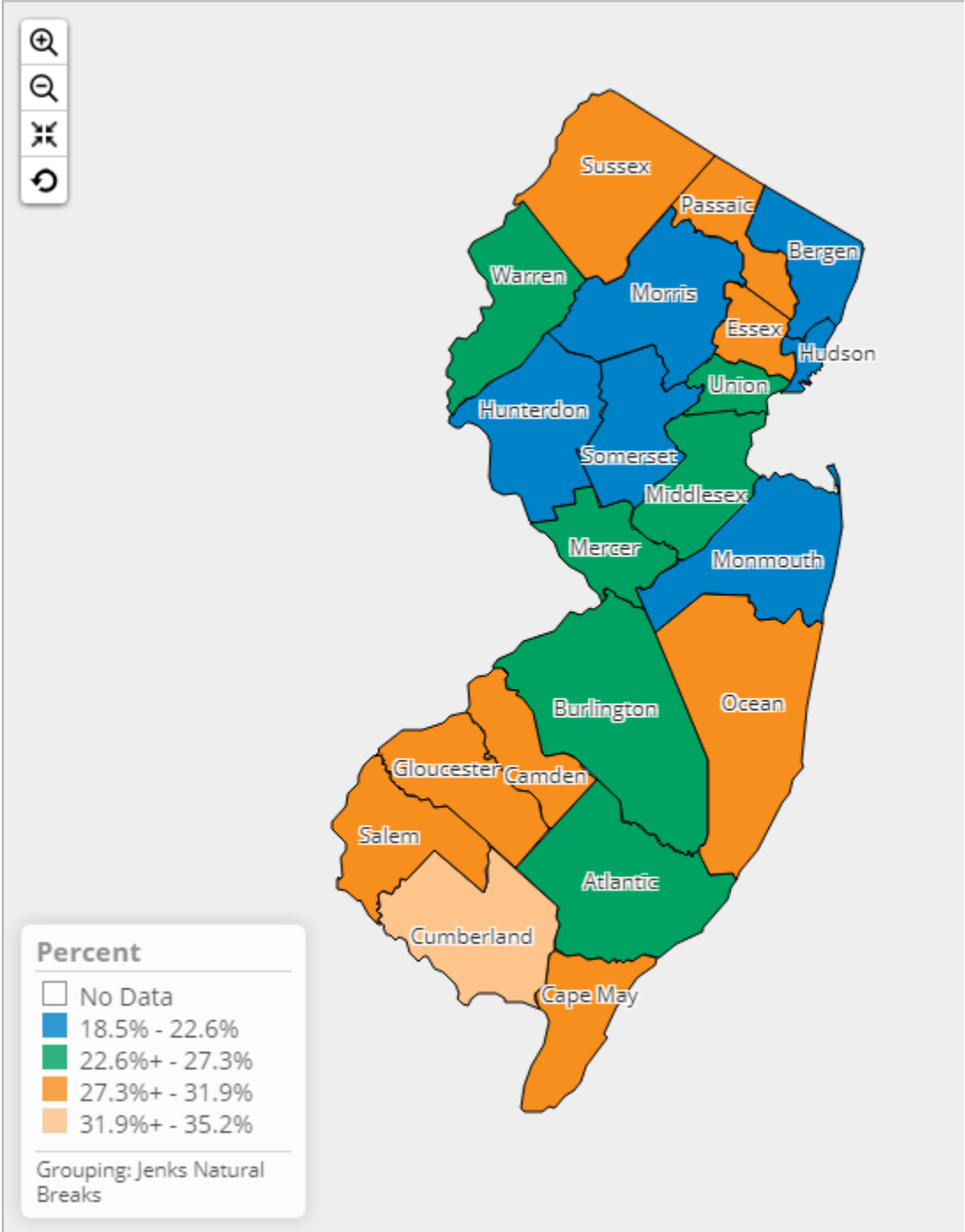
