



How to Order Respiratory Testing Online at PHEL



Step 1: Log in PHEL Orders and Reporting through <u>MyNewJersey</u> portal

Step 2: Fill out patient name, date of birth, and other demographics under "Patient Information"

Step 3: Use the search to find and check the appropriate order choice:

Select	Abbreviation	Name
	90798	Influenza Subtyping
	<u>95220</u>	Respiratory Pathogen Panel 2
	90850	Respiratory Viral Surveillance (Influenza + SARS-CoV-2)
	10010	SARS-CoV-2 Diagnostic Testing
	20212	SARS-CoV-2 Whole Genome Sequencing- Variant Identification

- Routine influenza/respiratory surveillance submission should select <u>Respiratory Viral Surveillance (90850).</u>
- Influenza Subtyping (90798) should be used for patients with laboratory confirmed <u>unsubtypeable</u> influenza infections or other suspected novel influenza cases.
- SARS-CoV-2 Diagnostic testing (10010) should be used if you want to receive a diagnostic report on the patient's COVID-19 status.
- Respiratory Pathogen Panel 2 (95220) and SARS-CoV-2 Whole Genome Sequencing (20212) <u>require prior approval</u> from PHEL before submission. For approval, contact phel.influenza@doh.nj.gov

Step 4: Complete all sections that are required under the "Clinical Info" field. Sections required are marked in red with an asterisk.

Step 5: Click Save in the bottom right corner to save and submit.

<u>Print out the requisition form</u> that pops up to accompany your sample to PHEL.
