GENERAL DESCRIPTION					

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Under supervision of a supervisory official in the Department of Human Services, supervises staff providing counseling services to a varied population of mental health clients, including those with multiple problems requiring rehabilitative services over an extensive period of time; supervises staff assisting clients to obtain the training and related services for vocational rehabilitation; and those assisting clients and employers in obtaining suitable employment or employees; does other related duties.

NOTE: The examples of work for this title are for illustrative purposes only. A particular position using this title may not perform all duties listed in this job specification. Conversely, all duties performed on the job may not be listed.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

NOTE: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.

Seven (7) years of professional experience in vocational/rehabilitational guidance or counseling, other related guidance and counseling, or social or medical casework in a rehabilitation agency, facility or other social program designed to increase the employability or social productivity of clients, including or supplemented by twenty-four (24) semester hour credits in a combination of the following areas: Vocational Counseling, Rehabilitation, Counseling, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, Vocational Guidance, Special Education or related areas.

OR

Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, including or supplemented by twenty-four (24) semester hour credits in a combination of the following areas: Vocational Counseling, Rehabilitation, Counseling, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, Vocational Guidance, Special Education or related areas; and three (3) years of the above-mentioned professional experience.

OR

Possession of a Master's degree in Vocational Counseling, Rehabilitation, Counseling, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, Vocational Guidance, Special Education or related areas; and two (2) years of the above-mentioned professional experience. NOTE: "Professional experience" refers to work that us creative, analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range and depth of specialized knowledge of the profession's principles, concepts, theories, and practices; and is performed with the authority to act according to one's own judgement and make accurate and informed decisions.



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LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
