Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) or autism is a neurobiological disorder that causes impairments in a person's social communication, interaction and behavior. In New Jersey, 1 in 34 children are diagnosed with autism. Knowing the prevalence of autism in New Jersey informs research into the cause(s) and facilitates planning for the services that individuals will need across

The New Jersey Autism Registry is a mandated registry that collects information on the prevalence of autism among New Jersey children up to 22 years of age. Staff analyze data and publish findings to inform the public and policy makers about trends seen in the Registry.

Under the direction of the Research Scientist 1 in Early Identification & Monitoring (EIM), the Research Scientist 3 will work collaboratively with program staff to maintain data, conduct analysis and publish reports. Important skills needed to be successful include the ability to prepare public-facing reports, participate in research and utilize SAS or other statistical software

Additional responsibilities of the position include maintaining and processing the more than 3500 autism registrations submitted annually; preparing or participating in the preparation of grant applications, research projects and reports; providing education and training to health care providers and information to families of registered children; providing analytical support for EIM quality assurance and compliance monitoring; working on Division-wide public health data initiatives; and analyzing data for departmental requests. Experience with Tableau or other data visualization program is preferred.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in a discipline appropriate to the position.

EXPERIENCE:

Two (2) years of experience in a field appropriate to the position.

NOTE: A Doctorate in a discipline appropriate to the position may be substituted for two (2) years of experience indicated above.

LICENSE:

Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
