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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the supervision of a physician or other supervisory officer in the Department of Human Services or in a local government jurisdiction, assists in the design and implementation of a movement therapy program, uses movement and other non-verbal techniques to accomplish treatment goals, plans movement activities to aide in the restoration, maintenance and improvement of disabled patients, may supervise the work of and participate in the training of therapy aides; does other related duties.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree with a major course of study in Dance, Dance Therapy or Dance Education.

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of experience providing movement therapy.

NOTE: For positions not requiring certification, a Master's degree in one of the above fields may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: Applicants may be required to possess a certification as a Dance Therapist Registered issued by the American Dance Therapy Association. This certification meets the above education requirement.

NOTE: Applicants who possess the higher level of certification, the Academy of Dance Therapist Registered, issued by the American Dance Therapy Association, are considered to have met the above certification requirement.
