	•	GENERAL DESCRIPTION	

Under the general supervision of a Research Scientist 1 or other supervisory official, this position oversees the planning,

development, administration, and implementation of the public health emergency preparedness exercise program for NJ Department of Health.

This position will manage the development of a Multi-Year (5-year) Integrated Preparedness Plan (MYIPP) in accordance with the exercise framework established by the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR) including the Exercise Framework Supplemental Guidance April 2024.

This position will lead and/or serve as ESF8 (public health) subject matter expert on multi-disciplinary planning teams to design, develop, conduct, and evaluate public health emergency preparedness exercises in accordance with FEMA Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) doctrine and established methods.

This position is responsible for the development, review and analysis of published after-action reports and improvement plans, and other available data to assess and identify the needed/required elements to improve statewide public health preparedness and response capabilities in accordance with established PHEP national standards.

This position staffs the State Emergency Operations Center, Emergency Support Function 8 desk when activated by NJ Office of Emergency Management as needed/required

Candidates with FEMA Master Exercise Practitioner Certificate preferred.

#### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

#### **EDUCATION:**

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Master's degree in a discipline appropriate to the position.

#### **EXPERIENCE:**

Three (3) years of full-time experience in a field appropriate to the position.

PHEL Candidates:

If you are a candidate for a position in our Public Health and Environmental Laboratories, you may be subject to pre- and /or post-

employment alcohol and drug testing.

**Direct Client Care:** 

If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care in one of the State facilities/programs, you may be subject to pre- and/or post-employment drug testing/screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at the candidate's expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result, or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement, will not be hired.

New Jersey First Act: In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-7, the "New Jersey First Act", all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey, unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in New Jersey, you have one year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey.

**Resume Note:** 

Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

**Authorization to Work:** 

Selected candidates must be authorized to work in the Unite States according to the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services Regulations. The State of New Jersey does <u>not</u> provide sponsorships for citizenships to the United States.
