GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This position plays a mission-critical role in maintaining the integrity and effectiveness of the Risk Management department's tracking and information systems. This includes ensuring compliance with The Joint Commission standards, Administrative Bulletins 3:18, Administrative Order 2:05, Patient Safety Act and Safe Patient Handling Act. The risk management department operates under time constraints, ensuring timely responses to Patient Service Compliance Unit (PSCU) calls within 24 hours, prompt and accurate entry into Unusual Incident Reporting and Management System (UIRMS) of incident reports, and adherence to the required timeframe for Employee Injury Form (RM-2) submissions. The role extends to preparing statistical and technical reports, initiating annual reports on patterns and trends, and assisting the treatment team with risk data for legal proceedings.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

LICENSE: A license as a Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey.

EXPERIENCE: Four (4) years of experience as a Registered Nurse, one (1) year of which is specialized experience including the monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and programs in a mental health, geriatric, health care setting, or human services agency.

NOTE: A Bachelor's degree, and three (3) years of specialized experience in the field of quality assurance in a mental health, geriatric, health care setting, or human services agency which includes monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and programs which may include allegations of abuse, neglect, exploitation, or incidents of client abuse or safety and well-being, may be substituted for the above license and experience requirements.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Public Health or a health care related field may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated specialized experience.

PHEL Candidates:

Direct Client Care:

If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care in one of the State facilities/programs, you may be subject to pre- and/or post-employment drug testing/screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at the candidate's expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result, or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement, will not be hired.

Resume Note:
