<p>EDUCATION:</p> <p>Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Nursing or related health field and a Master's degree with a major course of study in Nursing Supervision, Administration, Public Health, Medical Care, Nursing, Health Education, or related health field.</p> <p>NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required Bachelor's degree but possess an Associates degree in Nursing or graduated from an accredited School of Nursing may substitute two (2) years of additional clinical nursing experience as indicated.</p> <p>NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required Master's degree may substitute one (1) year of additional clinical nursing experience as indicated.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE:</p> <p>Six (6) years of clinical nursing experience in an acute care, long-term or community-based setting.</p> <p>LICENSE:</p> <p>Current registration as a Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey.</p>

PHEL Candidates:

**New Jersey
First Act:**

Resume Note:
