<p>The duties include the provision of consultation, review, and oversight of prehospital operational activities. Conduct comprehensive complaint investigations and prepare reports with conclusions and recommendations. Evaluate clinical care practices of basic and advanced life support, specialty care, and air medical services for changes and improvements. Prepare written reports containing findings, conclusions, and recommendations. Support the enforcement actions taken by the Attorney General on the Department's behalf. Schedule and conduct field site visits of both agencies and vehicles for regulatory compliance. Audit the records of prehospital agency staff to ensure the provisions of quality clinical care and the competency of staff.</p> <p>****Preference will be given to candidates who are currently certified as a paramedic by either the NJ Department of Health or the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians or will be eligible for and obtain such within six months from the date of appointment. EMT-Instructor certification is a plus.</p>			
REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)			
<p>NOTE: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.</p> <p>Six (6) years of experience as a paramedic or registered nurse in a mobile intensive care program providing advanced life support services.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; and two (2) years of the above-mentioned professional experience.</p> <p>NOTE: "Professional experience" refers to work that is creative, analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range and depth of specialized knowledge of the profession's principles, concepts, theories, and practices; and is performed with the authority to act according to one's own judgment and make accurate and informed decisions.</p> <p>LICENSE:</p> <p>Certification as Emergency Medical Technician by the New Jersey State Department of Health and Senior Services.</p>

PHEL Candidates:

If you are a candidate for a position in our Public Health and Environmental Laboratories, you may be subject to pre- and /or post-employment alcohol and drug testing.

Direct Client Care:

If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care in one of the State facilities/programs, you may be subject to pre- and/or post-employment drug testing/screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at the candidate's expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result, or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement, will not be hired.

**New Jersey
First Act:**

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-7, the "New Jersey First Act", all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey, unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in New Jersey, you have one year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey.

Resume Note:

Applicants who possess foreign degrees (degrees earned outside of the U.S.) are required to provide an evaluation indicating the U.S. equivalency prior to the closing date. Failure to do so may result in your ineligibility.

Authorization to Work:
