#### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Under the supervision of the Director of Nursing, will monitor all care activities for patients, ensuring nursing documentation are in compliance hospital policies and procedures and the Joinit Commission standards. Assigns nursing staff who provide daily patient care to on hopsital units. Oversee and ensure the consistent order of medical supplies; orient and train new clinical staff and provide timely feedback to nursing leadership for review. Conducts joint rounds with security supervisors on the units to ensure adherence to procedures and policies. Conducts monthly audits as assigned for use in the performance improvement strategies. This position will be evening shift hours: 2:45 - 11:15 pm.

#### REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited School of Nursing.

EXPERIENCE: Two (2) years of experience as a professional nurse in a hospital, clinic, school system, or other institution. (Private duty experience is not acceptable experience).

LICENSE: Registration or eligibility for registration as a professional nurse in the State of New Jersey.

Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

SPECIAL NOTE: A School Nurse Certificate issued by the New Jersey Department of Education will be required for appointment to educational facilities identified by the New Jersey Department of Education.

**Resume Note:**
