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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Division of Certificate of Need and Licensing, Office of Mental Health and Addictions Services - Under the supervision of the Program Manager, the Quality Assurance Coordinator provides oversite to the daily operations and projects within the unit. The Quality Assurance Coordinator supervises and supports staff and inspectors ensuring compliance of regulations and resolution of regulatory citations impacting or with the potential to impact the health, safety or welfare of our vulnerable clients identified through the inspection process. Participates in Office of Administrative Law hearings related to negative licensing actions and appeals; provides recommendations to facilities regarding policies and procedures, compliance with regulations/laws/rules and quality improvement; and provides technical assistance for currently licensed programs and those who would like to become licensed. Participates in projects as requested by the Commissioner's Office; and supports the Director's office as requested.

This position may be eligible to participate in the Department's pilot telework program, which offers eligible employees the opportunity to work remotely for up to two (2) days per week, as approved by management.

REQUIREMENTS (EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE / LICENSES)

LICENSE: A license as a Registered Nurse in the State of New Jersey.

EXPERIENCE: Five (5) years of experience in the monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and/or programs in a hospital or other health services facility or in a human services agency.

NOTE: A Bachelor's degree, and four (4) years of experience in the monitoring and/or evaluation of clinical or human services records and/or programs in a hospital or other health services facility or in a human services agency may be substituted for the above license and experience requirements.

NOTE: A Master's degree in Public Health or a health care related field may be substituted for one (1) year of indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
