I. New Multistate Guidance Concerning Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Accessibility Policies in Schools

The Attorneys General of multiple states, including New Jersey, have issued joint guidance regarding the Supreme Court's 2023 decision in *Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. V. President and Fellows of Harvard College (SFFA)* to clarify the legal landscape for institutions of higher education in light of recent federal actions, including executive orders, the Dear Colleague Letter (issued February 14, 2025), and the Frequently Asked Questions on Dear Colleague Letter about Racial Preferences (issued March 1, 2025). The guidance includes a legal overview of *SFFA* and frequently asked questions regarding guidance to improve postsecondary access and success with a focus on institutional missions, admissions, and recruitment practices and programs.

II. NJ Attorney General Secures Preliminary Injunction Regarding Defunding of Medical & Public Health Innovation Research

Attorney General Platkin, alongside a coalition of 21 other attorneys general secured a nationwide preliminary injunction against the Trump Administration for Defunding Medical and Public Health Innovation Research. The order prevents the Trump Administration, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), and the National Institutes of Health (NIH) from cutting funds for public health research at universities.
