Subject: Entities Engaged in Prohibited Activities with Russia/Belarus under C.52:32-60.1

Please be advised that the Governor's Office published the first list of companies determined to be engaging in prohibited activities with Russia and/or Belarus, which is available on the Division of Administration's website at: https://www.nj.gov/treasury/administration/. Companies listed are barred from doing business with the State of New Jersey, or other agencies as described below, including:

- (1) entering into or renewing a contract with a State agency, local contracting unit, boards of education, State college or county college for the provision of goods or services or the purchase of bonds or other obligations;
- (2) filing or renewing a Public Works Contractor Registration with the Department of Labor and Workforce Development;
- (3) being approved for or continuing to receive an economic development subsidy from the Economic Development Authority in but not of the Department of the Treasury, being awarded a municipal property tax abatement, or making or entering into a payment in lieu of property tax agreement;
- (4) applying for or receiving a tax clearance certificate from the Director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury;
- (5) being certified by the Department of Community Affairs as an urban renewal entity for purposes of the "Long Term Tax Exemption Law," P.L.1991, c.431 (C.40A:20-1 et seq.);
- (6) being designated as a redeveloper by a public agency for the purpose of planning, replanning, construction, or undertaking of any project or redevelopment work in accordance with the "Local Redevelopment and Housing Law," P.L.1992, c.79 (C.40A:12A-1 et seq.);
- (7) being invested in directly or indirectly in the funds under the management of the Division of Investment; and
- (8) banking with, having or holding stock, debt, or other equity investments of, or maintaining insurance coverage through a policy issued by a financial institution.

Attached is the revised "Certification of Non-Involvement in Prohibited Activities in Russia or Belarus" form. Any person or entity seeking to enter into or renew a contract with a State agency must complete the certification indicating whether or not the person or entity is engaged in prohibited activities in Russia or Belarus.

If institutions of higher education have questions about whether the company they wish to do business with is the same as what appears on the list, please contact OSHE@oshe.nj.gov.

This list will be updated on a rolling basis as needed.

Definitions

Vendor means: (1) A natural person, corporation, company, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, business association, sole proprietorship, joint venture, partnership, society, trust, or any other nongovernmental entity, organization, or group; (2) Any governmental entity or instrumentality of a government, including a multilateral development institution, as defined in Section 1701(c)(3) of the International Financial Institutions Act, 22 U.S.C. 262r(c)(3); or (3) Any parent, successor, subunit, direct or indirect subsidiary, or any entity under common ownership or control with, any entity descr bed in paragraph (1) or (2).

Engaged in prohibited activities in Russia or Belarus means: (1) companies in which the Government of Russia or Belarus has any direct equity share; (2) having any business operations commencing after the effective date of this act that involve contracts with or the provision of goods or services to the Government of Russia or Belarus; (3) being headquartered in Russia or having its principal place of business in Russia or Belarus, or (4) supporting, assisting or facilitating the Government of Russia or Belarus in their campaigns to invade the sovereign country of Ukraine, either through in-kind support or for profit.
