Subject: Release of Dual Enrollment Study Commission Report

The Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) and New Jersey’s Department of Education (NJDOE) is pleased to announce the release of the New Jersey Dual Enrollment Study Commission report.

The Commission was established through legislation signed by Governor Phil Murphy (P.L. 2018, c.145) and charged with studying “issues related to the implementation of an expanded dual enrollment program” and issuing a framework expanding dual enrollment.

NJDOE and OSHE are also releasing website resources, including a step-by-step toolkit, and providing technical assistance for high schools and colleges looking to expand their dual enrollment offerings.
