## **Bias & Discrimination Resources**

New Jersey has made combating bias and hate a top priority. See more from the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General (OAG):

- No Hate in the Garden State is a campaign from the OAG providing resources and data to help address the rise in bias incidents. This site features a <u>Bias Data Dashboard</u>, which includes information about bias motivations, where incidents are occurring, responses to frequently asked questions, and other resources.
- <u>The New Jersey Divion on Civil Rights' Education and Training Unit</u> offers a variety of anti-discrimination trainings to educate about rights and responsibilities under the law. ## New Jersey Joins Amicus Brief Challenging Student and Faculty Visa Revocations

New Jersey Attorney General joined a coalition of states in filing an amicus brief in *American Association of University Professors, et al., v. Marco Rubio, et al.* related to the Federal Administration's "Ideological Deportation Policy," which revokes noncitizen students and faculty of their immigration status based on their expression and beliefs.
