Announced on International Transgender Day of Visibility by Governor Phil Murphy, this information hub exists to assist New Jersey's transgender and nonbinary community in finding information on important programs and services. Some of the information available on this one-stop hub includes, but is not limited to: finding mental health resources, obtaining medical support, understanding legal protections, and acquiring legal assistance. This website will provide insight into the rights of transgender and non-binary students.

This streamlined website is a result of engagement with the transgender and non-binary community. The site will be launched as a beta version, allowing for continual updates and enhancements based on feedback from stakeholders.
