Choking Prevention Unit (Resource Team)



- IDENTIFY HIGH RISK INDIVIDUALS THROUGH INCIDENT REPORTS
- PROVIDE TRAININGS
- INDIVIDUAL EATING PLANS
- INTERPRET SWALLOW STUDIES
- LIAISON WITH PCP & OTHER SLP





Resource Team

- ADDRESS ISSUES WITH DYSPHAGIA (SWALLOWING PROBLEMS)
- RELATED MEDICAL ISSUES
- COMMUNICATION & HEARING





Swallowing Problems

- Individuals are at high risk.
 - Aspiration (material in the lungs)
 - Sepsis
 - Death
- Problems develop with aging.
- Polypharmacy





Dysphagia

- Coughing during meals.
- Eating too quickly.
- Diet texture downgrade.





DIETS

- REGULAR DIET: NOTHING CUT UP. FOOD SERVED WHOLE.
- CHOPPED DIET: FOOD IS CUT UP TO ½ INCH BY ½ INCH
- GROUND DIET: FOOD IS APPROXIMATELY
 1/4 INCH BY 1/4 INCH (TEXTURE OF MINCED, GROUND BEEF)
- PUREE DIET: NO SIZE BECAUSE THE TEXTURE NEEDS TO BE SMOOTH AND CREAMY (LIKE PUDDING OR APPLE SAUCE).
