Petitioner challenges the reduction of his Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program ("SNAP") benefits. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On July 12, 2018, a plenary hearing was scheduled, but because Petitioner abandoned the hearing prior to its commencement, the Honorable Kimberly A. Moss, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), took no testimony and admitted no documents.

On July 16, 2018, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, finding that Petitioner abandoned his appeal when Petitioner abruptly left the hearing room, without good cause, while the ALJ was on the bench, and did not return. See Initial Decision at 2. Therefore, the ALJ concluded that the Agency's reduction of Petitioner's SNAP benefits must be affirmed. Ibid. I agree.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were received.

As the Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have considered the ALJ's Initial Decision, and following an independent review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's final conclusion in this matter and hereby ADOPT the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law in this matter.

Accordingly, the Initial Decision in this matter is hereby ADOPTED, and the Agency is hereby AFFIRMED.
