### FINAL DECISION

OAL DKT. NO. HPW 11123-19 G.H.

AGENCY DKT. NO. C123005004 (CAMDEN COUNTY BOARD OF SOC. SVCS.)

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's denial of Work First New Jersey/General Assistance ("WFNJ/GA") benefits. The Agency denied Petitioner WFNJ/GA benefits, contending that she had been convicted for possession of a controlled dangerous substance ("CDS") with the intent to distribute, which precludes Petitioner from eligibility for said benefits. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On September 9, 2019, the Honorable John S. Kennedy, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony, and admitted documents.

On September 30, 2019, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, affirming the Agency's determination. Here, the record reflects, and Petitioner admitted, that in 2005, she was convicted for possession and the intent to distribute a CDS. See Initial Decision at 2-3; see also Exhibit R-1 at 5-10. Based on the foregoing, the ALJ found that regulatory authority prohibits the Agency from granting WFNJ/GA benefits to Petitioner. See Initial Decision at 3; see also N.J.A.C. 10:90-18.6(b)(1)(ii)(3). Accordingly, the ALJ concluded that Petitioner was ineligible for WFNJ/GA benefits, and that the Agency had properly denied Petitioner said benefits. *Ibid.*; see also Exhibit R-1 at 1-4. I agree.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were received.

As the Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have considered the ALJ's Initial Decision, and following an independent review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's final conclusion in this matter and hereby ADOPT the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law.

Accordingly, the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED, and the Agency's determination is AFFIRMED.
