FINAL DECISION

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's denial of an extension of Emergency Assistance ("EA") benefits and the termination of EA benefits. The Agency denied Petitioner an extension of EA benefits, and terminated Petitioner's EA benefits, contending that she had exhausted her lifetime limit of EA benefits and did not qualify for an extension of those benefits. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. A hearing was initially scheduled for January 16, 2020, but was adjourned. On February 20, 2020, the Honorable Jude-Anthony Tiscornia, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony, and admitted documents. On February 25, 2020, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, affirming the Agency's determination.

This office has been advised that the Agency is rescinding its termination of Petitioner's EA benefits. Therefore, as Assistant Commissioner, Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I find that, as a contested case no longer exists, this matter has now been rendered moot, and as such, I hereby DISMISS Petitioner's appeal.

Accordingly, as no contested case exists in this matter, Petitioner's appeal is hereby DISMISSED.
