Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's denial of EA benefits. The Agency denied Petitioner EA benefits due to a failure to cooperate. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") for a hearing. On March 18, 2020, the matter was scheduled for a plenary hearing before the Honorable Andrew M. Baron, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ").

Also on March 18, 2020, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, reflecting that the matter was resolved, as, on the date of the hearing, Petitioner went to the Agency offices and provided whatever remaining documents were necessary, and the Agency therefore agreed, on the record, to reinstate Petitioner's eligibility and place her in a shelter. See Selliement Agreement. While Petitioner did not appear at the OAL for the hearing, as Petitioner had now provided whichever documentation the Agency required, and to provide Petitioner EA benefits, the ALJ approved the settlement, ex parte, which was put on the record. See Initial Decision at 3.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were received.

As Assistant Commissioner, Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have reviewed the ALJ's Initial Decision and the record, and I hereby ADOPT the ALJ's Initial Decision, and AFFIRM the Settlement Agreement terms.

Accordingly, the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED, and the settlement terms are AFFIRMED.
