As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this matter including the Initial Decision and the contents of the OAL case file. No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were filed. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to render a Final Agency Decision is August 3, 2015, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10, which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on June 17, 2015.

I hereby ADOPT the findings, conclusions and recommended decision of the Administrative Law Judge in their entirety and incorporate the same herein by reference. United Healthcare is only obligated to provide services to its members. See Article V., Section 5.5D of the Medicaid Contract. Here, it is undisputed that Petitioner voluntarily disenrolled from United Healthcare and enrolled in another

Medicaid Managed Care Organization prior to the hearing. Consequently, the issue regarding the provision of adult medical day care services by United Healthcare is moot.

THEREFORE, it is on this *22nd* day of July 2015,

ORDERED:

That the recommended decision dismissing Petitioner's appeal is hereby ADOPTED.
