As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file and the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement reached by the parties. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is November 7, 2016 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on September 21, 2016.

This matter arises from the termination of Petitioner's Medicaid benefits due to excess income. At the scheduled OAL hearing, the parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby Petitioner provided updated income information. Petitioner agreed to have his benefits end on September 30, 2016 in accordance with the termination letter and Passaic County would issue a new eligibility outcome letter based on this new information. By Initial Decision dated September 16, 2016 the ALJ approved the settlement agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this  $\mathcal{A}^{10}$  day of NOVEMBER 2016,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
