

excess income. The parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby Respondent agreed that Petitioner's total household income is below the income limit for NJ FamilyCare. As a result, Respondent agreed that Petitioner was eligible for benefits, effective August 1, 2018.


The ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
