


This appeal stems from United Healthcare's denial of Petitioner's request for Private Duty Nursing (PDN) Services. However, by Settlement Agreement filed with the Office of Administrative Law, the parties agreed to amicably resolve this controversy whereby United Healthcare agreed to provide Petitioner with 10 hours per day of PDN services pending a reassessment. The ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this 10th day of SEPTEMBER 2018,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
