

modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on August 13, 2018.

This matter concerns the termination of Petitioner's benefits due to excess income. The Settlement Agreement indicates that Petitioner's income has been reduced due to a change in hours. Passaic County agreed to review this new information and determine if Petitioner is eligible. As benefits were not continued pending the fair hearing, this change in income will result in a new eligibility outcome letter. In the Initial Decision dated August 6, 2018, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{28th} day of AUGUST 2018,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
