As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file and the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement reached by the parties. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is June 15, 2018, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on May 12, 2018.

This matter arises from Hudson County Department of Family Services' denial of Petitioner's Medicaid eligibility based on Petitioner's resources exceeded the maximum allowance. The parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby Petitioner agreed to


withdraw his request for a Fair hearing without prejudice. By Initial Decision dated April 24, 2018, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings. The matter has been withdrawn and Petitioner may reapply for benefits at any time. I hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{5th} day of JUNE 2018,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
