# Medicaid Only Failure to Verify Eligibility Appeal N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2 and -2.3

### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Respondent terminated petitioner's Medicaid benefits for failure to provide the following evidence of eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e): Application for Medicaid filed on 7/19/24. RFI sent on 1/14/25

via regular mail to DAR in New York. Petitioner's application was denied on 2/5/25 for failure to respond. Petitioner received mailed RFI on 2/12/25 and requested an extension of time. County granted extension until 2/18/25. On 2/18/25 petitioner sent fax with list of documents to County. However, two documents were sent on 2/19/25. County would not accept documents sent on 2/19/25.

# FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.

I FIND that petitioner or petitioner's representative is AUTHORIZED to pursue this appeal; therefore, I CONCLUDE that standing has been established.
I FIND that petitioner or petitioner's representative is NOT AUTHORIZED to pursue this appeal; therefore, I CONCLUDE that standing has not been established.
I FIND that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a), and that no exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); therefore, I CONCLUDE that the Medicaid Only application should be DENIED under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e).
I FIND that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a), but that exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); therefore, I CONCLUDE that the time limit for verification should be EXTENDED under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c).
I FIND that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a); exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); and petitioner has since provided all the required documentation; therefore, I CONCLUDE that the Medicaid Only application should be PROCESSED to determine eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71.
I <b>FIND</b> that petitioner timely provided all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a); therefore, I <b>CONCLUDE</b> that the Medicaid Only application should be <b>PROCESSED</b> to determine eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71.
ADDITIONAL FINDINGS OF FACT/CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
G.S. had Medicaid since 5/23/23 but was terminated at renewal in
2024. County possessed many documents requested in RFI. County
took 6 months to process application but provided G.S. a three-
day extension on Friday 2/14/24 requiring production by 2/18/24.
Petitioner attempted to cooperate with RFI upon receipt of same.
Exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c).

production in renewals.
