

transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) for a hearing. On October 28, 2024, Petitioner did not appear for the prehearing conference. Ibid. During the conference, Horizon advised the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) that they would be filing a motion to dismiss, as Horizon had agreed to continue Petitioner's stay at the facility. Ibid. Later that day, on October 28, 2024, Horizon filed the motion to dismiss. Ibid. Petitioner did not respond to the motion. Ibid.

In the Initial Decision, the ALJ found that the relief being sought by Petitioner was agreed to by Horizon and therefore the ALJ granted Horizon's motion to dismiss, as there is no greater benefit Petitioner may receive by proceeding. ID at 2-3. I agree. As Horizon has rescinded their denial of Petitioner's continued stay and treatment, dismissal of the matter was appropriate.

Accordingly, based on the record before me and for the reasons set forth above, I hereby ADOPT the Initial Decision as Horizon has rescinded their denial of Petitioner's continued stay and treatment.

THEREFORE, it is on this 1st day of FEBRUARY 2025,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED.
