**Name of Program:** Integrated Care Program

**Purpose:**

This Request for Proposals (RFP) is issued by the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) for the implementation and promotion of the Integrated Care Program (ICP). The purpose of this ICP initiative is to support behavioral health services provided by a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) or FQHC Look-Alike as a means to enable an FQHC to integrate behavioral health services into their existing practices. The RFP is funded through the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's (SAMHSA) State Opioid Response (SOR) grant.

This initiative will promote the integration and co-location of physical and behavioral healthcare to improve overall wellness and physical health status of individuals with opioid use disorder (OUD) and other behavioral health conditions. The program is expected to promote the implementation and improvement of bi-directional integrated care services including; evidence-based or evidence-informed screening, assessment, diagnosis, prevention, treatment, and recovery services for individuals with an OUD and/or stimulant use disorder. With this initiative, DMHAS aims to improve the health outcomes for individuals with behavioral health conditions by supporting an integrated care model for behavioral and primary physical health. Two awards were made in the total amount of \$665,928.00.
