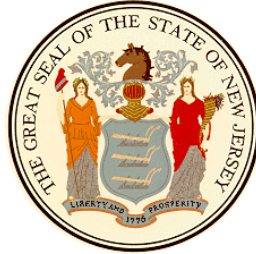

The statewide ***Substance Use Overview*** provides statistics on substance use disorder treatment in New Jersey for calendar year 2024. In 2024, there were 81,217 treatment admissions and 78,797 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services by substance use disorder treatment providers. These data were submitted through the web-based New Jersey Substance Abuse Monitoring System (NJSAMS). This report is based on the information provided in the March 2025 NJSAMS download data.

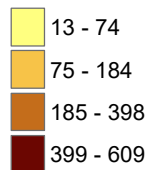

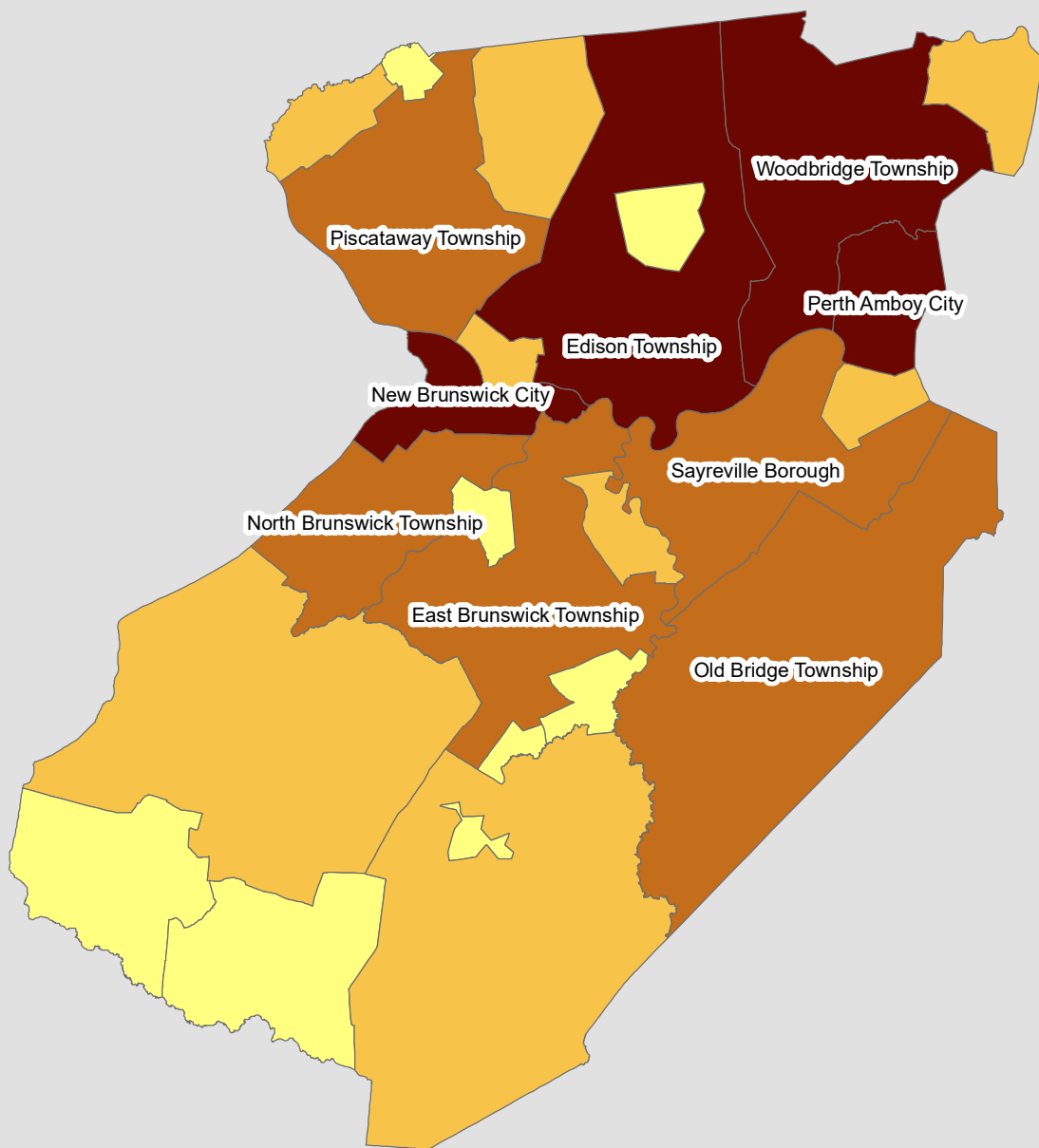
# 2024 Middlesex County Substance Use Admissions by Municipality of Residence
