New Business: Open Discussion/ Announcements	Devin Reminded all that he CAC is for consumers and their family members. Ann pointed out that one does not have to be a member to attend meetings and share ideas. Kathleen Dobbs add that it is important to be on the consumers' level on understanding, or they will be labeled as "junkies" but Jeff pointed out that we need to inform the division first, not the public. Debbie asked if there are currently any educational efforts that aim to reduce the stigma among addiction treatment providers. Ana added that it is important to check the health status, and understand the difference between one that's addicted versus one that's psychotic.	Ann will send out more information about the trainings and see if it's beneficial and if they're available to come speak to the CAC to learn more about what they do and the value of their trainings.
	Discussion went on to cover the topic of "Stigma". Discussion focused on education — who needs to be educated, how do we go about doing so, the possibility of advocacy efforts, available resources, etc. Future CAC meetings need to focus on specifics — where to put our efforts and what we hope to get out of them. Liaisons' Reports and Actions CAC want to take regarding the committee:	Devin is getting people travel vouchers and has spoken with Don asking regarding CAC members attending internal meetings. Devin reported on his meeting with the executive director of the YMCA in NYC. The Y has agreed to pilot a recovery program in Queens and Staten Island for the High School After School program. New Jersey is trying to start a recovery high school since the state doesn't have one yet.	Devin will try to get access to the curriculum at the Union Community College Diploma program.
	Devin reported that there are collegiate recovery programs such as the program for Juniors and Seniors at Union community college. The program is funded by Prevention Links. Devin noted that New Jersey can support people in recovery through recovery community centers, high schools, and colleges. New Business: Open Discussion/ Announcements	Ann announced a Strategic Planning Work Group scheduled for April 4 th at Trenton Psychiatric. Anyone wishing to attend should bring ID. This is a workshop to address the move to managed behavioral health care. Ann – Discussed how victims Hurricane Sandy access medication and what can be done to improve the system prior to the next big storm. Ann pointed out that 200 patients did not receive their medications. Debbie – Noted that there is a need to find the people that experienced barriers to giving or obtaining medication. People went to the shelters yet	

	didn't indicate that they needed medication. Ann - There needs to be education to shelters on emergencies and needed treatment medication. K. Dennis – asked if there is snapshot of what services NJ has to offer in cases of emergency. Ann handed out Nominal Group Process details. Ann noted that the nominal group technique is a group problem solving process involving problem identification, solution generation, and decision making. It can be used in groups of many sizes, who want to make their decision quickly, as by a vote, but want everyone's opinions taken into account
