What is Narcan (naloxone)?

Narcan (naloxone) is an opiate antidote. Opioids include heroin and prescription pain pills like morphine, codeine, oxycodone. Narcan is a prescription medicine that blocks the effects of opioids and reverses an overdose.

Find out more about opioid overdose risks and the opioid antidote Narcan at this community education workshop.

All trainings will be provided by credentialed addiction counselors and licensed nurses in a small, confidential setting to allow participants to receive "hands on" training.
