What is Narcan (naloxone)?

Narcan (naloxone) is an opiate antidote. Opioids include heroin and prescription pain pills like morphine, codeine, oxycodone. Narcan is a prescription medicine that blocks the effects of opioids and reverses an overdose.

Find out more about opioid overdose risks and the opioid antidote Narcan at this community education workshop.
