Certificate Program in Trauma Response and Crisis Intervention

This clinical certificate program is designed for clinicians, mental health professionals, and practitioners from other disciplines who wish to enhance their knowledge and skills in the field of trauma response and crisis intervention. Workshops will address a

variety of traumatic events such as interpersonal violence, natural disaster, terrorism, and personal/family crises. Workshops offered in this certificate program are designed as clinical workshops. Certificates of completion are offered after each workshop and upon completion of the final certificate. Participants not seeking the full certificate program are welcome to take individual workshops.

This certificate program entails 13 Days in Total:

9 Required Workshops

- 1. The Effects of Trauma across the Developmental Spectrum (2 days) 10 CE Hours, Clinical
- 2. Foundations and Models of Crisis Intervention (2 days) 10 CE Hours, Clinical
- 3. Responding to Disaster 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 4. Self-Care in Trauma Work 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 5. The Ethics of Trauma and Disaster Response: Doing Right, Doing Good 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 6. Family Treatment Approaches in Working with Trauma 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 7. Group Treatment Approaches in Working with Trauma 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 8. Individual Treatment Approaches in Working with Trauma 5 CE Hours, Clinical
- 9. Differences and Diversity in the Experience, Effects and Treatment of Trauma 5 CE Hours, Clinical
