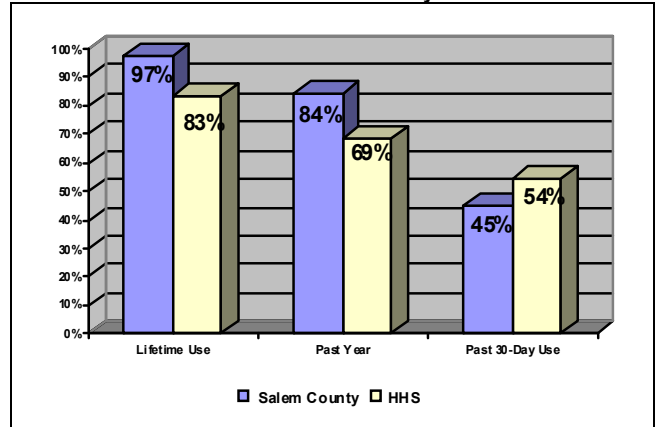


Data were collected on 248 clients in 2010 who went through the Salem County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center program or were monitored by the Salem County IDRC. 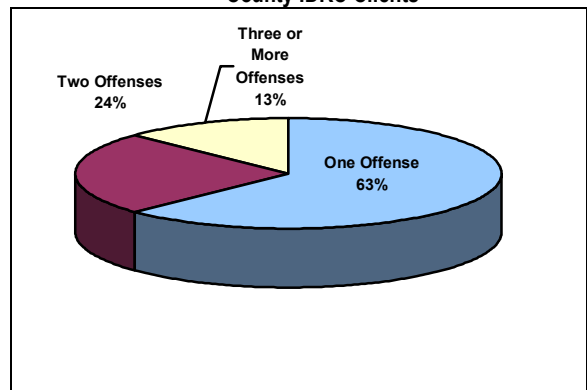

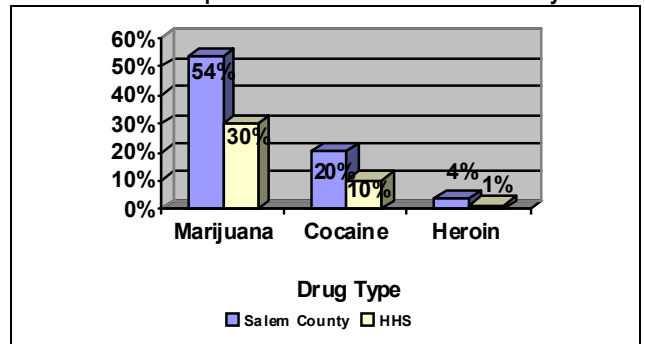
**Alcohol Use by Salem County IDRC Clients Compared with 2009 NJ Household Survey**



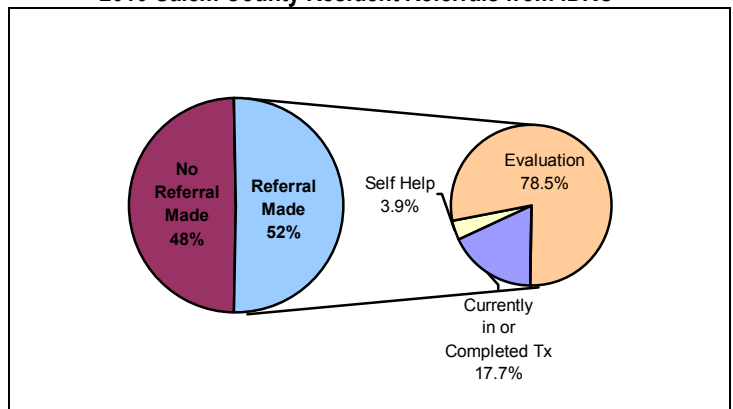
**Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Salem County IDRC Clients**

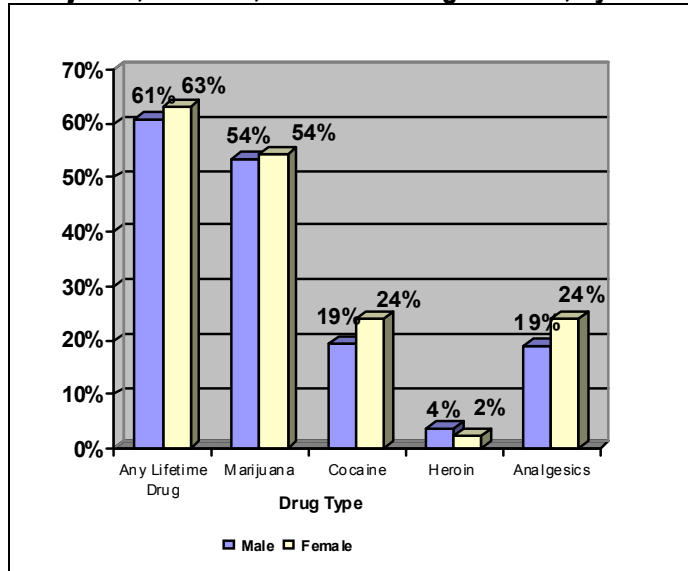
