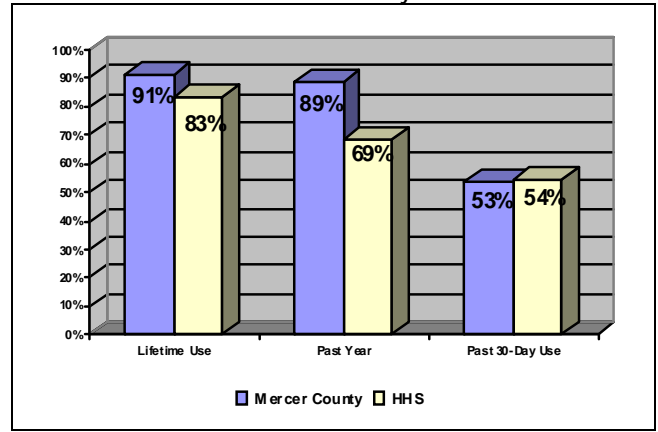


Data were collected on 819 clients in 2011 who went through the Mercer County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center (IDRC) program or were monitored by the Mercer County IDRC. The following tables and graphs give demographic information about these clients. Clients' reported alcohol and other drug use characteristics are also described. Information was gathered from a mandatory self-administered questionnaire given during the IDRC classes and the counselors' supplemental entries into the New Jersey Substance Abuse Monitoring System (NJSAMS).

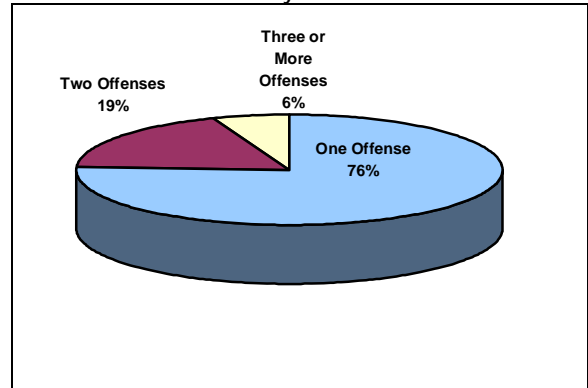

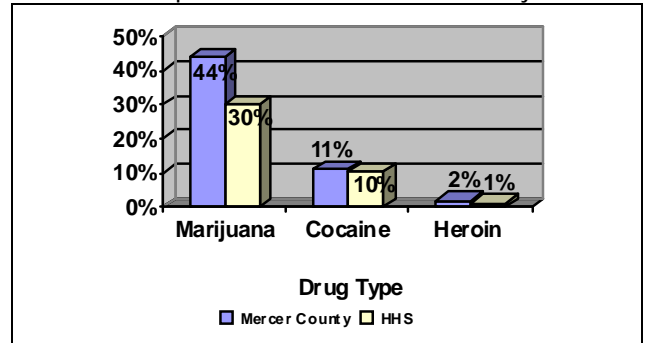
Alcohol Use by Mercer County IDRC Clients Compared with 2009 NJ Household Survey



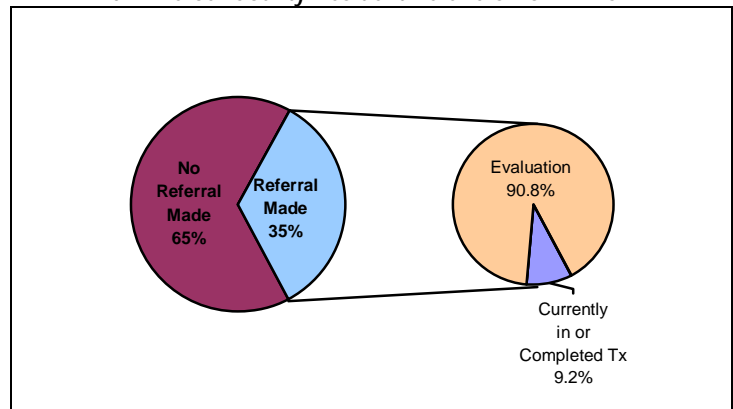
Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Mercer County IDRC Clients

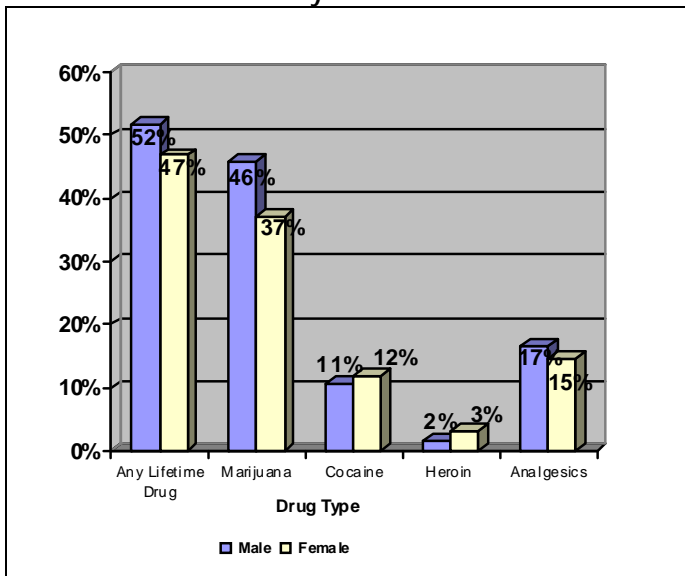
