[2.1] Percent of Alcohol treatment needs derived from the 2009 New Jersey Household Survey on Drug Use and Health (Technical Report pages 3-89 & 3-90 Abuse and Dependence in past year).  
[2.2] Need for Alcohol treatment in each county is the product of the adult population in each county (Column 1) times the percentage in need of alcohol treatment (Column 2.1)  
[3] Drug treatment need is estimated by applying a two-sample Capture-Recapture statistical model using the 2008 and 2010 NJ-SAMS data.  
[3.3] Percent of Drug treatment need was derived by dividing the population in need of treatment in each county (Column 3.2) by the adult population in that county (Column 1) times 100.
