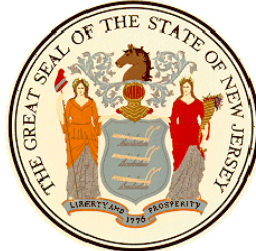

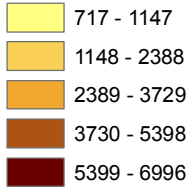

# 2010 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

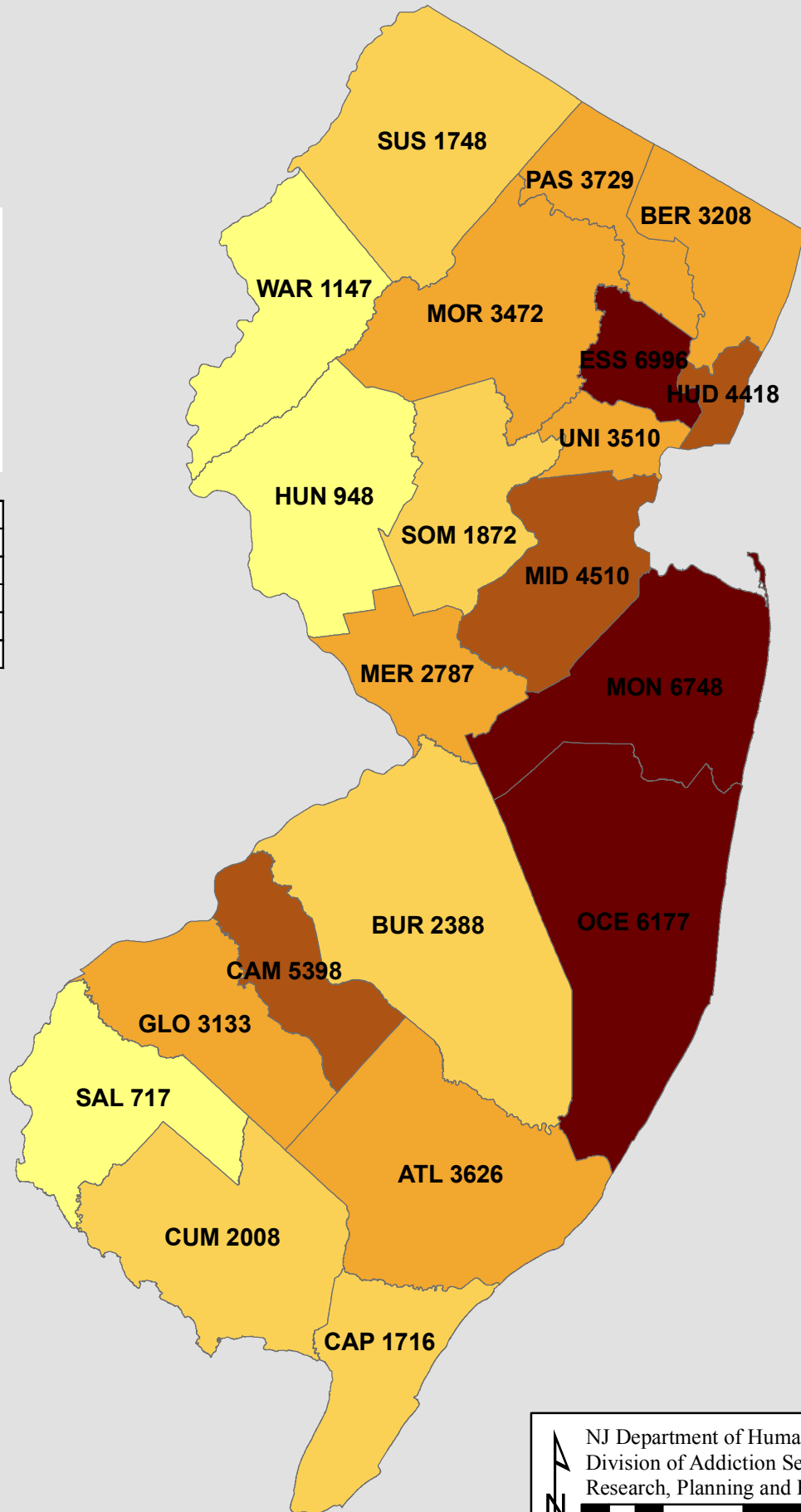

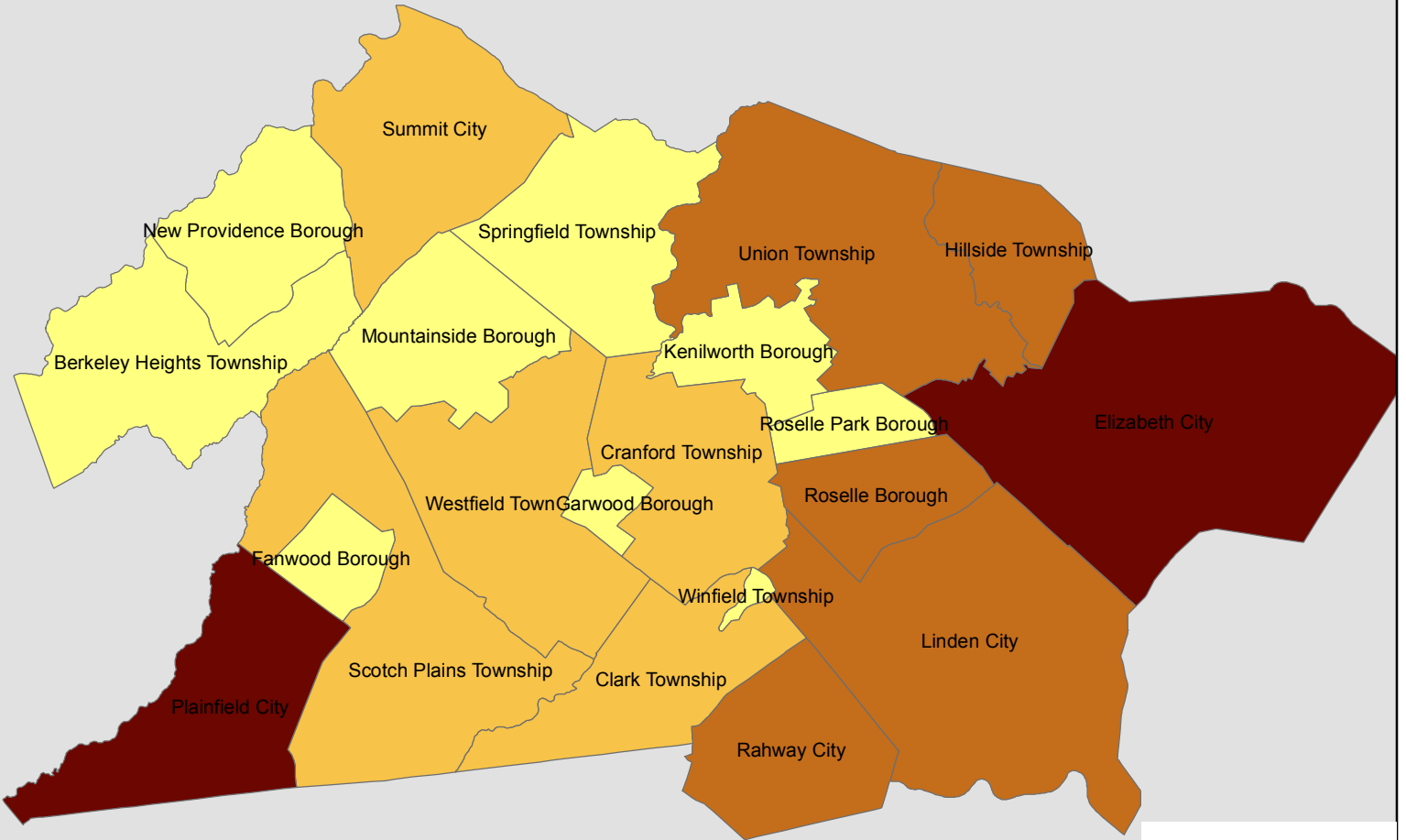

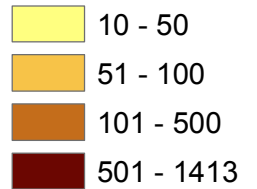
