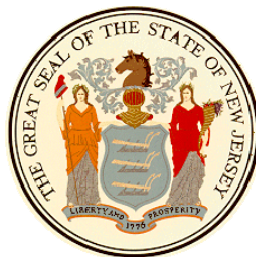

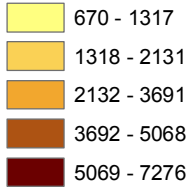

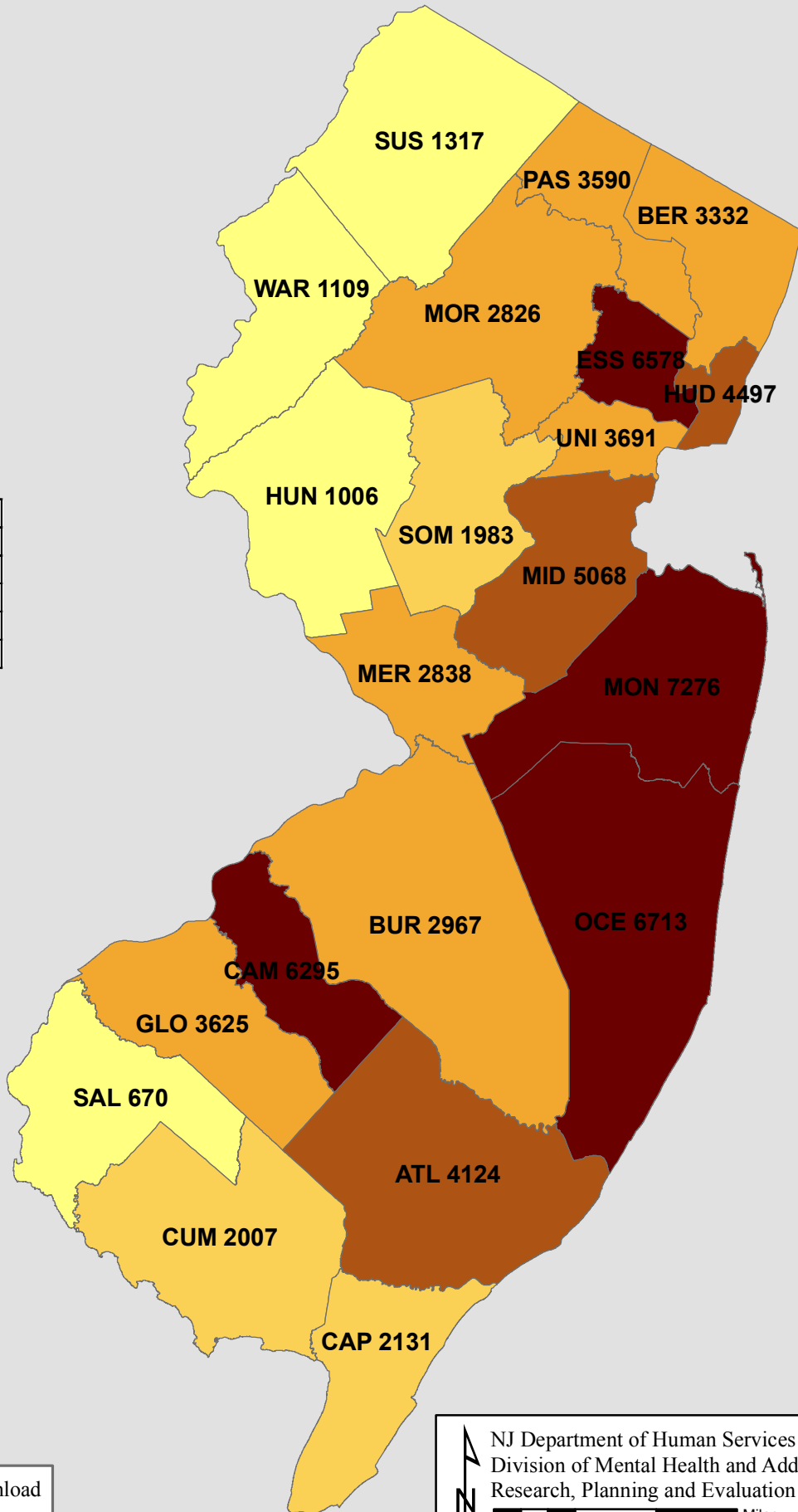
2012 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

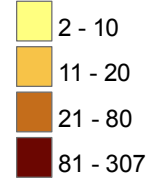

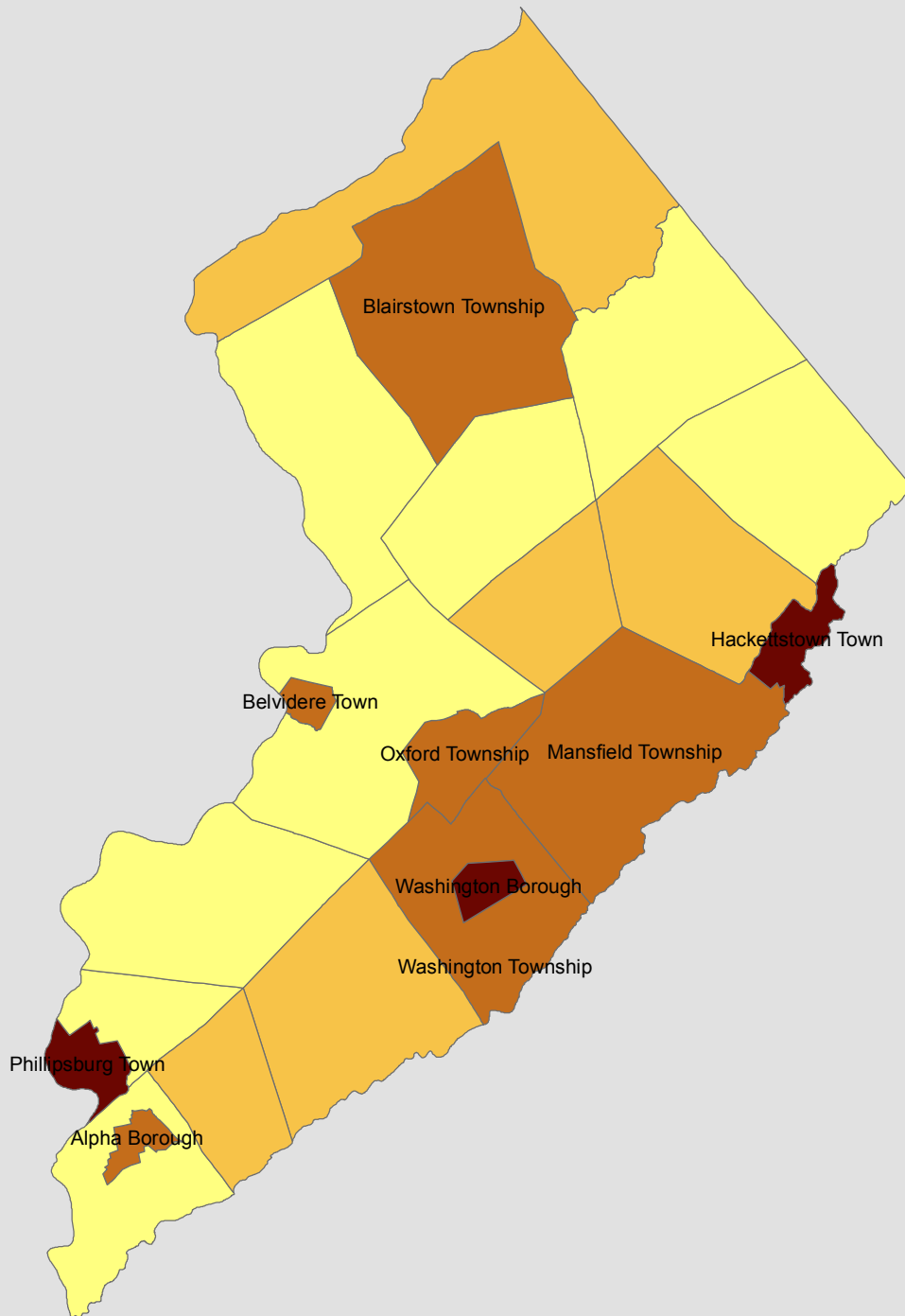
2012 Warren County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
