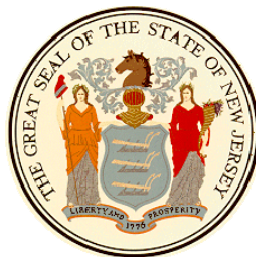

This *Substance Abuse Overview* provides statistics on substance abuse treatment in each New Jersey county for calendar year 2012. In 2012 there were 75,837 treatment admissions and 73,036 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 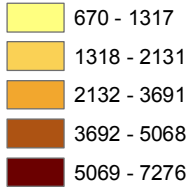

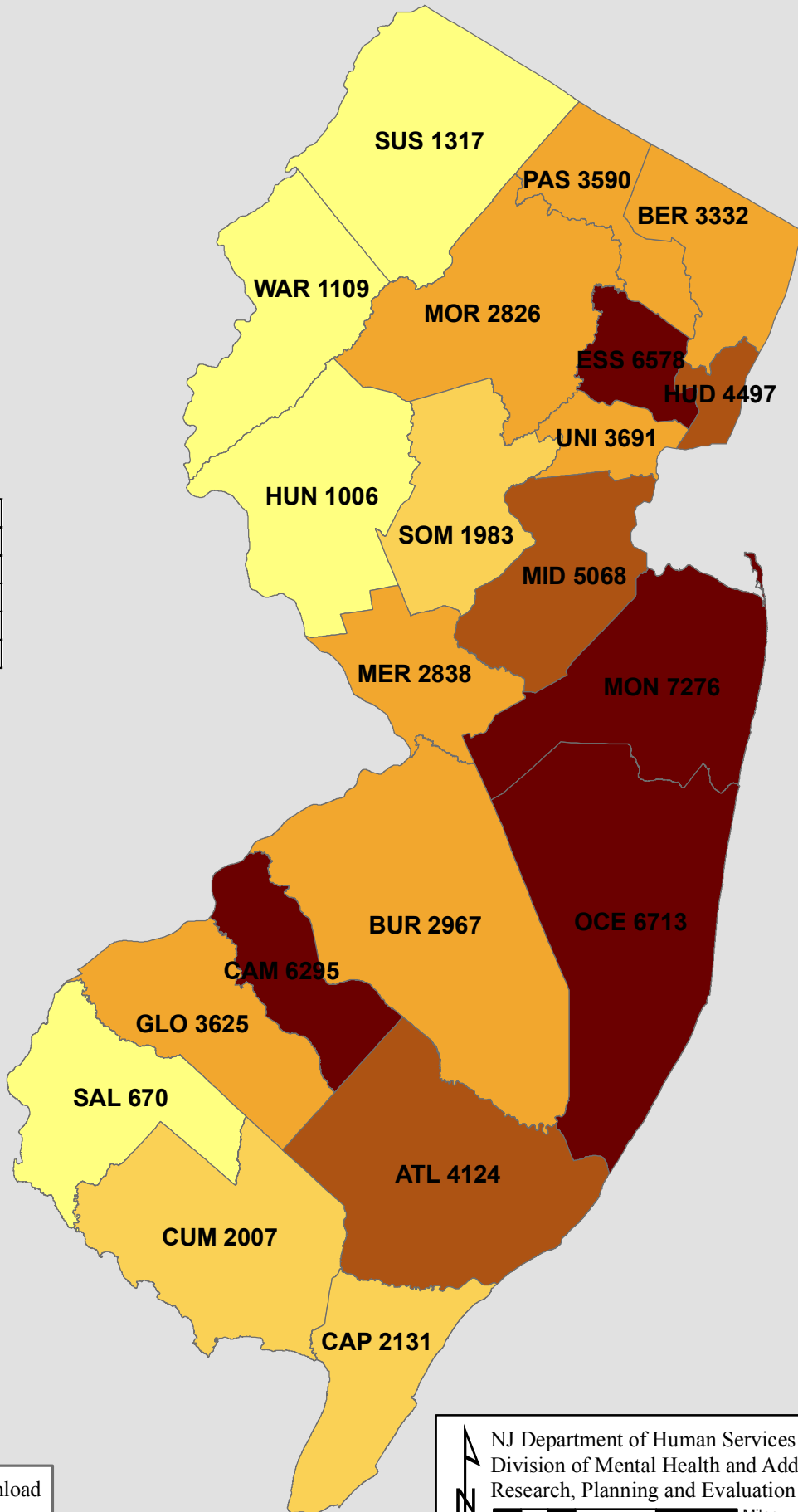
# 2012 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

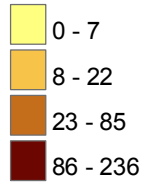

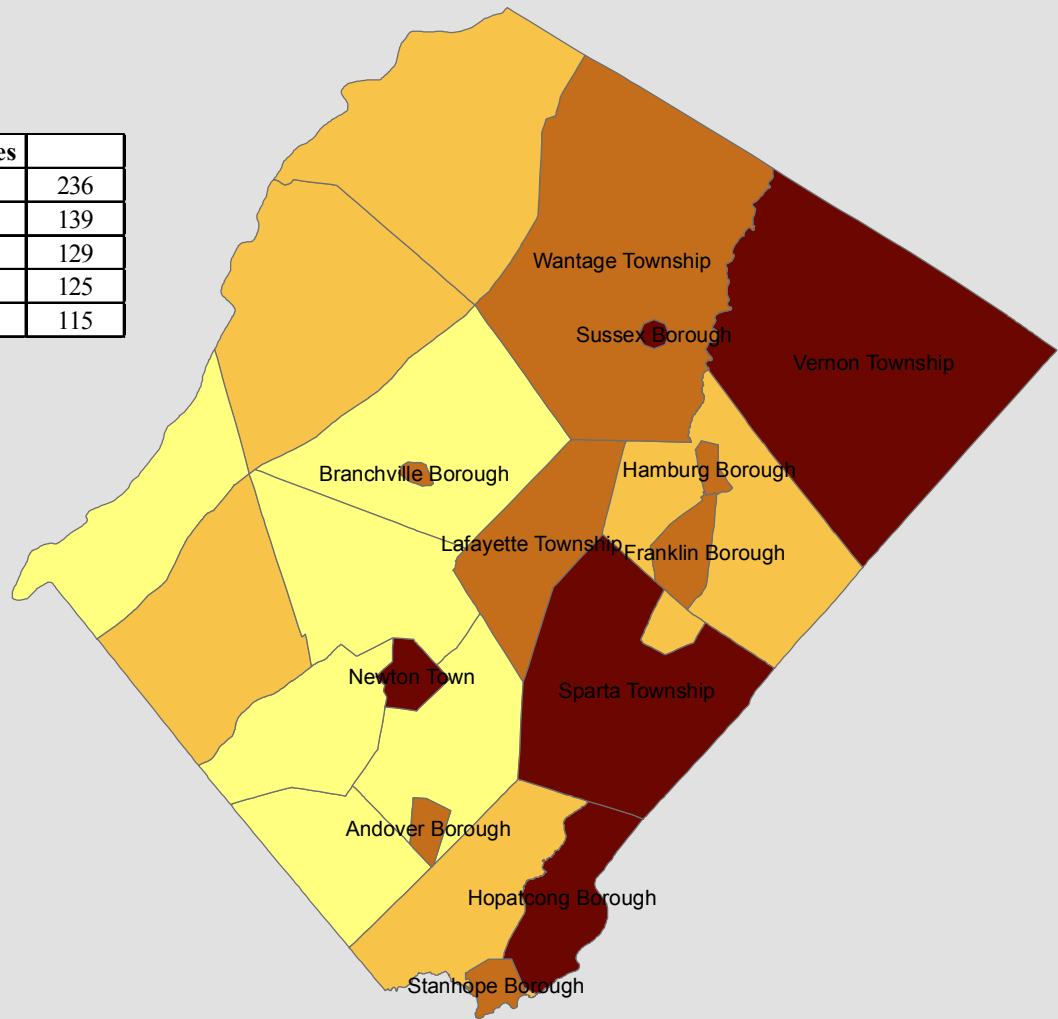
# 2012 Sussex County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
