The Excluded New Jerseyans Fund (ENJF)

Required Documents



If you were excluded from both the federal stimulus checks and COVID-19 related unemployment assistance, you may qualify for the ENJF program. ENJF is a one-time cash assistance program where eligible households will receive a benefit of \$1,000 per eligible individual and \$2,000 per household. Applicants must demonstrate eligibility using any of the following documents under each category.

Exclusion from Federal Stimulus and COVID Related Unemployment Assistance

- Bank statements for the months: April & May of 2020, December 2020 & January 2021, and April 2021 & May 2021 showing no federal stimulus checks or any COVID-19 related assistance. This includes, Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA).
- Applicants who do not have a bank account should still apply for the Fund and our eligibility workers will be in touch with you.

NOTE: Receipt of these benefits only applies to the applicants; therefore, if another member of your household for example your child received this payment, it will not preclude you from applying as long as you did not receive either of these relief payments.

COVID Impact
