<b>DEFINITION:</b>	Under close supervision of a supervisory official in the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Department of Human Services, does the field instruction, provides advice, and makes appropriate referrals to help newly blinded persons adjust to the loss of vision; does other related duties.				
<b>REQUIREMENTS</b>					
<b>REQUIREMENTS:</b>	<b>NOTE:</b> Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester-hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience.				
	Five (5) years of professional experience in providing instruction or other social services to the blind.

	Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; and one (1) year of the above-mentioned professional experience.				
<b>REQUIREMENTS:</b>	<b>NOTE:</b> Appointees will be required to successfully pass a Braille assessment, administered by the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired.				
	<b>NOTE:</b> "Professional experience" refers to work that is analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range of basic knowledge of the profession's concepts and practices; and is performed with the authority to act and make accurate and informed decisions.				
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<b>LICENSE:</b>	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.				
<b>IMPORTANT NOTICES</b>					
<b>FOREIGN DEGREES:</b>	Degrees and/or transcripts issued by a college or university outside of the United States <u>must be evaluated</u> by a reputable evaluation service at your expense. The evaluation must be included with your submission. Failure to submit the required evaluation may result in an ineligibility determination.				
<b>RESIDENCY:</b>	In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (NJ PL 70), the "New Jersey First Act", all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey (NJ), unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in NJ, you have (1) year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to NJ.				
<b>DRUG SCREENING:</b>	If you are a candidate for a position with DHS, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing <u>will be at your expense</u> . Candidates with a positive drug test result, or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement, will not be hired.
