NOTE: Although a variety of degrees may satisfy the requirements, majors related to such areas as engineering, science, mathematics and business are not accepted. NOTE: Licensure as a Professional Nurse in the State of New Jersey or a degree as a Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy from an accredited school of medicine may be substituted for the Bachelor's degree.
