At least fifteen (15) semester hour credits should be in courses relevant to clinical psychology such as: learning theories, human motivation, personality theories, human growth and development, psychopharmacology, and statistics and research. EXPERIENCE: Completion of a one (1) year supervised full-time clinical internship or one (1) year of extensively supervised clinical experience.
