Equipment Distribution Program

Provides specialized telecommunications and home safety equipment to New Jersey residents who meet eligibility requirements.

Outreach Specialists for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing

Provide presentations and training on communication strategies, assistive technology, hearing loss awareness, cochlear implants, and hearing aids.

NJ Hearing Aid Project

Provides low-income seniors with access to reconditioned hearing aids. Used hearing aids are collected from the community, refurbished and made available to eligible applicants.

Information and Referral

Requests from consumers, providers, and the community at large are received and responded to via email, division Web site, voice telephone and video phone on all matters related to hearing loss.

Case Management

Is provided to individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing to assist in negotiating services provided by the public and private sector.

Advocacy

Is provided to consumers who have difficulty receiving accommodations as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act and the NJ Law Against Discrimination.
