AGENCY DKT. NO. V546505 (ESSEX COUNTY DIVISION OF WELFARE)

Petitioner appeals from Respondent Agency's denial of his application for Emergency Assistance ("EA") in the form of a shelter placement. The Agency contends that Petitioner failed to register at his shelter placement on the day he was required to do so thereby causing his own homelessness, which then resulted in the Agency imposing a six-month ineligibility penalty on Petitioner. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On May 11, 2015, the Honorable JoAnn LaSala Candido, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held an emergent plenary hearing and took testimony.

On May 11, 2015, the ALJ issued her Initial Decision affirming the Agency's determination. The ALJ found that Petitioner did not demonstrate good cause for failing to timely register at the shelter. See Initial Decision at 2. The ALJ therefore ordered, and I concur, that the Agency's denial of Petitioner's EA application be affirmed.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were filed by either party.

As the Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have considered the ALJ's Initial Decision and following an independent review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's decision and hereby adopt the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law in this matter. Because the Petitioner caused his own homelessness without good cause, he is ineligible for EA for a period of six months. See N.J.A.C. 10:90-6.1(c)(3).
