**FINAL DECISION** 

OAL DKT. NO. HPW 6127-15 L.P.

AGENCY DKT. NO. GA292074 (ESSEX COUNTY DIVISION OF WELFARE)

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's determination regarding the effective date of her Work First New Jersey/General Assistance ("WFNJ/GA") benefits. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On May 27, 2015, the Honorable Richard McGill, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony and admitted documents.

On May 29, 2015, the ALJ issued his Initial Decision, reversing the Agency's determination. The ALJ found that upon redetermination of Petitioner's WFNJ/GA benefits, on December 8, 2014, her redetermination application was filed away and was never processed. See Initial Decision at 2. Thereafter, on March 9, 2015, Petitioner filed a new application for WFNJ/GA benefits and was awarded prorated WFNJ/GA benefits for March 2015. Ibid. However, the ALJ found that due to administrative error in processing Petitioner's December 8, 2014 redetermination application, she was entitled to WFNJ/GA benefits retroactive back to the date the administrative error first occurred, and ordered the Agency to provide Petitioner with a corrective payment of WFNJ/GA benefits at a rate of \$210 per month for the period from December 8, 2014, to March 8, 2015. Ibid.

No Exceptions to this Initial Decision were filed.
