On REMAND HMA 12209-2013

As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the Initial Decision, the Settlement Agreement and the documents in evidence. No exceptions were filed. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Agency Decision in this matter is October 3, 2014 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on August 19, 2014.

This matter concerns the overpayment of \$7,979.32 in Medicaid benefits due to Petitioner's failure to disclose income she and her husband received from the Department of Human Services as a Community Care Provider. By way of settlement, Petitioner withdraws the request for a fair hearing and agrees to comply with a payment plan. In the event of default, the remaining balance will be sent to the Set-Off of Individual Liability Program (SOIL) to recoup the overpayment.

By Initial Decision dated August 14, 2014, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings. Thus, I hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this day of OCTOBER 2014

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement is hereby ADOPTED.
