FINAL DECISION

AGENCY DKT. NO. GA478946 (ESSEX COUNTY DIVISION OF WELFARE)

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's denial of Work First New Jersey/General Assistance ("WFNJ/GA") benefits. The Agency denied Petitioner WFNJ/GA benefits contending that Petitioner failed to provide the requested documentation required to determine her WFNJ/GA eligibility. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On November 9, 2015, the Honorable Mumtaz Bari-Brown, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a plenary hearing, took testimony, and admitted documents.

On December 1, 2015, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, reversing the Agency's determination. The ALJ found that Petitioner made a good faith effort to provide the Agency with all necessary information to clarify her status for Unemployment Insurance Benefits ("UIB"), when she provided the Agency with a UIB printout showing that she had zero benefits available to her, indicating that she did not qualify for UIB. Accordingly, the ALJ found that the Agency's denial of Petitioner's WFNJ/GA application was improper, on that basis.

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were received.

As the Director of the Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have considered the ALJ's Initial Decision, and following an independent review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's final conclusion in this matter and hereby ADOPT the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law in this matter.

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Accordingly, the Initial Decision in this matter is hereby ADOPTED and the Agency's determination is REVERSED.
